

Lenny's Limo

For 2 to 4 players, ages 4 and up

Contents:

30 Cards, plus 8 large format cards (4 Front End and 4 Back End cards)

Object:

To have the longest limo at the end of the game.

Set Up:

- Give each player 1 Front End card and 1 Back end card. Set extras aside
- Shuffle deck. In center of playing area place all cards face down so that no cards are on top of any other.

Play:

- Youngest player goes first.
- Players take turns turning over two cards from the face down cards.
 - If the cards **do not match** (one left and one right side of a matching illustration), player turns them back over, putting them back in the same space that they found them. It is then the next player's turn.
 - If the cards **do match**, (when put together they complete a scene), player adds them to his/her limo. Create one long, silly limo illustration by placing the cards in a row.
- Player gets an additional turn for each pair they match.
- When a player fails to match two cards on their turn it is the next player's turn.
- Once all of the cards have been matched, and there are no cards left in the center play area, players complete their limos by placing the front and back cards on either end of the row of cards.

Winning the Game:

The player with the longest limo after all of the matches have been made is the winner.
